One full day safari Masai Mara: Big Migration time (July-October) or Big 5 during the rest of the year. Starting at 5:45 in the morning to 4 o'clock in the afternoon. There is a choice to come back to the camp for lunch and then go out from 3:30 to 6:30 in the evening to see the sun set.

On our bushwalk included in the package shows the kids basic survival skills such as tracking wildlife on foot and which plants to use & to avoid in the bush. Get ready to be active and use a bow and arrow in our archery class or throw a Maasai spear!
